Discussion Questions

Peace Received – Jesus meets us and calms our fear

Why do you think Jesus speaks peace before giving a command?
What does that tell you about His heart?

Can you think of a time when Jesus brought peace into your life
in the middle of fear or uncertainty?

Christ Revealed – We rejoice seeing the risen Jesus

Are we truly glad when we see Jesus, or do we treat Him like the
Principal? How would you honestly answer that?

What habits or practices could help you “see” and rejoice in
Jesus more this week?

Mission Commissioned – We are sent just as Jesus was sent

Jesus was sent in humility, truth, love, obedience, and power.
Which of these traits do you find most difficult to imitate? Why?

If someone observed your life this week, what would they
assume you’ve been “sent” to do?

Spirit Empowered – We are not sent alone or empty

Where in your life are you trying to do ministry or mission in
your own strength rather than the Spirit’s?

What difference does it make to know that the Spirit is already
working ahead of you?

Forgiveness Extended – We carry the keys of grace

What does it mean that we have been given the authority to
extend God’s forgiveness to others through the gospel?

How can we ensure we are faithfully duplicating Christ’s key and
not one we’ve modified or dulled?

Family Discussion

Why do you think a key only works if it matches the original?
Who is the "original" we are supposed to copy as Christians?

What are some ways we can "look like Jesus" in how we act, talk, and love others? Can you think of someone who reminds you of Jesus?

Have you ever had a chance to share Jesus with a friend or help someone feel God's love? How did it feel? What would you do next time?

What are some ways our family can help others know about Jesus this week? Can we pray for someone together or do something kind as a family?
