Discussion Questions

The Seeking Shepherd

In what ways do we resist seeing ourselves as the lost sheep rather than part of the ninety-nine? How does the image of Jesus as the Good Shepherd challenge our pride and comfort?

The Searching Woman

How does the image of the lost coin challenge our view of self-worth and contribution to salvation? In what ways do we struggle with believing that salvation is fully God's work and not our own?

The Running Father

How does the father's response to the prodigal son reshape our view of repentance and grace? When have you struggled to believe that God would welcome you back after failure? How can we model the father's joy and grace toward those who return to God?

The Other Lost Son

What attitudes of the elder brother do you sometimes see in yourself? Why do you think Jesus leaves the story open-ended? What choice is He putting before us? How can we guard against bitterness when God shows grace to others? What does it look like in daily life for us to join the Father's joy over the lost being found?

Family Discussion

Can a coin find itself when it's lost? What does that show us about how God finds us when we're lost?

Why do you think the woman in Jesus' story was so happy when she found her lost coin, even though it wasn't worth very much money?

What are some ways we can join in God's joy when we see someone come to know Him or come back to Him?

What will you think about when you see your coin this week?

Pray for Missions – India

Largest Religion – Hindu, 74.3% **Population** – 1.46 Billion

Percent Evangelical – 2.2% **Area** – 1,269,219 square miles

The world's least-evangelized peoples are concentrated in India. Of 159 people groups of over 1 million people, 133 are unreached. Also, 953 ethnic groups have populations greater than 10,000; of these, 205 have no church and little to no outreach from Christians. Catholics represent the largest Christian group in India (nearly 20 million). People respect their charity work, as Catholics run more than 5,000, healthcare facilities. Orthodox Christians in India trace their origin to the Apostle Thomas who is thought to have ministered there in the 1st century. They have the strongest presence in Kerala and southwest India.
