## Discussion Questions

### **1. The Disciples Who Could Not See (Luke 18:31–34)**

Jesus spoke plainly about His suffering, death, and resurrection, why couldn't the disciples see what was right in front of them?

How does Paul's teaching in 2 Corinthians 4:4–6 help us understand why people we love sometimes don't respond to the gospel?

When you think of loved ones who seemed blind to Christ, what emotions come up for you? How does entrusting them to God's mercy bring comfort?

### **2. The Beggar Who Truly Saw (Luke 18:35–39)**

The beggar called out "Jesus, Son of David." Why is that significant? How does Isaiah 35 help us understand what he believed about Jesus?

What does it say about his faith that he shouted even louder when the crowd tried to silence him? Where in your own life do you need to refuse to be silenced by the crowd as you cry out to Jesus for mercy?

What does the irony of the disciples being blind but the blind beggar seeing reveal about the kingdom of God?

### **3. Jesus Who Opens Eyes (Luke 18:40–43)**

Jesus stopped on His way to the cross to give His attention to one blind beggar. What does this reveal about His character and His priorities?

What is the significance that the man's first sight was Jesus Himself, and that his immediate response was to follow Him and glorify God?

## **Family Discussion**

Use these questions this week to help your child remember what they learned.

What do you see when you close your eyes really tight?

How would it feel to walk around all day and never see your mom or dad's face, or the trees, or the sky?

When the blind man in our story couldn't see, what did he do?

What's the first thing you think you would want to see if Jesus gave you your sight?

Even though we can see with our eyes, why do we need Jesus to help us see with our hearts?

## **Pray for Missions – Nepal**

**Largest Religion** – Hinduism, 81.3%      **Population** – 29.6 million

**Percent Evangelical** – 2.8%      **Area** – 56,827 square miles

Situated on the border of China and India, the government of Nepal is taking an increasingly strong stand against religious conversion. There is a small, visible Christian community in Nepal, but despite the 2015 constitution that guaranteed religious freedom, Parliament criminalized converting someone to another religion. Christians face false accusations, harassment and beatings from family and communities. They also face opposition from local Hindu nationalists who envision Nepal becoming a "pure" Hindu nation. Christians are seen as people who "destroy culture" and promote foreign religions. Pray for these Christian communities that they would boldly witness for Christ despite harassment and risk.
