Discussion Questions

1. The Revealing of the King

Read verses 31–33. What strikes you most about the way Jesus describes Himself here? How does this image of the Son of Man in glory challenge or confirm your usual picture of Jesus?

2. The Division of the Nations

Why do you think Jesus chose the image of a shepherd separating sheep and goats? We see that the Shepherd knows His sheep. What are some practical ways believers can cultivate a deeper awareness of His voice in daily life?

3. The Blessing of the Righteous

The righteous were surprised by Jesus' commendation, what does that tell us about the heart posture of genuine faith? How does grace transform the way we see "ordinary" acts of compassion?

4. The Judgment of the Unrighteous

The goats' failure was not hostility but indifference. Why is indifference toward others such a serious spiritual danger? How do comfort or busyness keep us from seeing Christ in others?

5. The Final Destiny and the Hope of the Gospel

The cross proves that justice and mercy meet perfectly in Christ. How does the cross make it possible to stand before a holy God without fear? How can we live today in light of the final words: "Come, you who are blessed by My Father"?

Family Activity

Try doing this as a family to keep the message fresh this week.

When we sorted things out, did we make things fit into one category or the other? When Jesus comes again, He will show the world who truly loves Him.

How do you think Jesus can tell who really loves Him? What are some ways we can listen for Jesus' voice now?

Jesus said, that when you help someone hungry or lonely, you're really serving Him. Why do you think Jesus cares so much about the people the world forgets?

The Bible says one day everyone will see that Jesus is King. How do you think that day will feel for people who already love Him and have been waiting for Him? How does that make you feel — to know that Jesus will make everything right?
