What does the tabernacle (a tent in the middle of Israel's camp) reveal about God's desire to be near His people?

Why do you think David danced "with all his might" when the ark came into Jerusalem? What does this moment say about David's understanding of God's presence?


David wanted to build God a house, but God said, "I will build YOU a house." What does this reversal teach us about grace?

When the temple was finished and the glory cloud filled the house, what would the people of Israel have believed this moment symbolized? Do you think Israel confused God's nearness with God's approval? How can we fall into the same trap?

Israel loved having God close enough to bless them, but not close enough to change them. Where do you see that tendency in your own walk? How does Solomon's divided heart warn us against settling for the appearance of God's presence instead of true communion with Him?

How does the failure of Solomon and the limits of the temple stir a longing for a greater Son of David and a greater dwelling of God? Do we really want God to dwell among us?
