

**Monday:** Psalm 136:1, *“Give thanks to the Lord, for He is good, for His steadfast love endures forever.”* Thanksgiving begins not with our blessings but with His character. What part of God’s character do you need to thank Him for today?

**Tuesday:** Deuteronomy 8:10, *“And you shall eat and be full, and you shall bless the Lord your God for the good land He has given you.”* Every good thing in our life, food, home, work, family, comes from God’s hand. List three ordinary ways God provided for you today.

**Wednesday:** Lamentations 3:22–23, *“His mercies never come to an end; they are new every morning.”* Jeremiah wrote these words in the middle of heartbreak. Thanksgiving is not pretending life is easy. It is remembering that God’s mercy is deeper than our weariness. What “new mercy” did God give you this morning?

**Thanksgiving Day:** 1 Thessalonians 5:18, *“Give thanks in all circumstances; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you.”* Thanksgiving is not an emotion; it is an act of trust. What is one difficult thing you can thank God *in* today?

**Friday:** Ezekiel 36:26, *“And I will give you a new heart, and a new spirit I will put within you.”* Our deepest gratitude flows from the new heart God gives. He does not wait for us to fix ourselves. Where have you seen God softening or reshaping your heart lately?

**Saturday:** Psalm 73:28, *“But for me it is good to be near God.”* The return from exile did not fix Israel’s heart. But God promised to be with His people still. Where did you sense God’s nearness this week?

**Sunday:** We give thanks not only for what God has done, but for what He will do. His kingdom cannot be shaken. His covenant cannot be broken. His promises cannot fail. What promise of God do you need to cling to with gratitude as you enter Advent?
