## Discussion Questions

1. Why do you think it is easy to agree that God should be glorified, but harder to live as though that is truly our chief end? What areas of life do you most naturally associate with God's glory, and which areas do you tend to separate from it?
2. When difficult or unexpected circumstances enter your life, what is your instinctive interpretation? Do you tend to see them as interruptions, punishments, detours, or opportunities?
3. Paul rejoiced that Christ was preached even when others had wrong motives and he was personally affected. What are some subtle ways we seek to protect our reputation, even while doing good or religious things? How does the desire to be seen as faithful, right, or competent sometimes compete with the desire for Christ to be magnified?
4. Paul's statement "to live is Christ, and to die is gain" reveals what he valued most. What might change in your daily life if you truly believed that nothing essential could be taken from you because Christ is your life?
5. Paul calls believers to live in a way that is "worthy of the gospel." What do you think that phrase means, and what does it not mean? How does unity among believers display the worth of the gospel to the watching world?
6. Paul describes suffering for Christ as something that has been "granted." Why is it uncomfortable to think of suffering as a gift rather than a failure or inconvenience? How does fear often reveal what we value most? What does faithful endurance look like in a culture that prioritizes comfort, safety, and self-preservation?
