Discussion Questions

Where are you most tempted to define “growth” the way the world does, and how does Philippians 2 redefine it through Timothy and Epaphroditus (Phil. 2:19–30)?

What do we learn about Timothy’s relationship to the Philippians from Acts 16, and how does that backstory shape Paul’s confidence in sending him (Acts 16:1–15; Phil. 2:19–24)?

How does Epaphroditus’ mission and suffering illuminate what “loving generously” looks like in a local church (Phil. 2:25–30; 4:10–19)?

What is one way you have been hurt or disappointed by church life, and what might it look like to pursue growth without resorting to disappearance or isolation (Heb. 10:24–25; Eph. 4:15–16)?

Who is one person you could intentionally help “grow higher” this month, and what specific act of self-giving love would serve their spiritual good (Gal. 6:2; 1 Thess. 5:11)?

Where do you most need the church’s support right now, and what would it look like to let others hold you up rather than trying to grow alone (Rom. 12:4–5; 1 Cor. 12:21–26)?

Join one of our Breaking Bread Groups where we get together as families and individuals to discuss the things that God is teaching us through his word. We usually have some good food too. There is more information about our current groups on the back table.

Family Discussion

- Why do you think God made plants need time, water, and support to grow? What does it mean to grow as a Christian? Is it just getting older or knowing more things?
- Why do you think God wants Christians to grow together instead of alone?
- What are some things that make growing hard, either in a garden or in our lives? Why do you think God sometimes lets growing be uncomfortable or challenging?
- Today we heard that growing often means giving ourselves away. What do you think that means?
- How can we trust God even when we don't see growth right away?
