## Discussion Questions

Paul says he “learned” contentment. What has helped you learn (or struggle to learn) contentment? How do you tell the difference between being responsible with resources and finding your security in them?

Why is contentment necessary for generosity? What happens when we try to give without being secure in Christ?

In what ways can generosity be about more than money (time, presence, emotional energy, hospitality, advocacy)?

How does thinking of generosity as “fruit” rather than “credit” change the way you view giving?

The sermon emphasized that “the giver gets the glory.” How can generosity unintentionally shift glory from God to ourselves? What is the difference between giving as a beneficiary and giving as a benefactor?

Why is it important that verse 19 grounds God’s provision “according to His riches” rather than our performance? How does remembering the cross reshape the way we think about giving?

Is it harder for you to give or to receive? Why? If someone observed your life for a month, what would your generosity say about your hope? What practical step could you take this week to express generosity as worship?

*Join one of our Breaking Bread Groups where we get together as families and individuals to discuss the things that God is teaching us through is word. We usually have some good food too. There is more information about our current groups on the back table.*

## Family Discussion

- What does it mean to be “content”? (A: Being okay and trusting God whether we have a lot or a little.)
- Why could Paul be content even when he didn’t have much? (A: Because Jesus was enough for him.)
- If Jesus takes care of us, why don’t we have to be afraid to share? (A: Because God will keep taking care of us.)
- What are some things we can share besides money? (A: Toys, time, snacks, kindness, helping someone, inviting someone to play.)
- Who is the real Giver of everything we have? What has he given us in Christ? (A: Salvation, grace, new life, hope, love, adoption...)
- Repeat this together: “The giver gets the glory.” Then explain simply: “When we share, we show that God is the one who gave to us first.”
