Discussion Questions

Read Philippians 4:21-23. The word “greet” implies embrace, welcome, and recognition. How does that deepen your understanding of what Christian fellowship should look like?

What does it mean that believers are called saints? How does remembering that holiness is belonging (not superiority) change how we see ourselves and others?

Why do you think Paul emphasizes “every” saint? What kinds of walls or divisions does that word challenge in our lives?

What stands out to you about believers existing within “Caesar’s household”? What does that tell us about the reach of the gospel? How might God use your current circumstances as opportunities rather than obstacles?

What fears most often keep you from speaking about Christ? Rejection? Awkwardness? Not knowing enough? Something else? How does the promise that the grace of Jesus is with our spirit reshape the pressure we feel about evangelism?

Who first shared the gospel with you? What risks or sacrifices might that person have taken to speak to you?

Who is the person you wrote down as your “one”? Share their first name (or initials) with the group. Why do you feel burdened for this person specifically?

What might be the biggest barrier between you and a gospel conversation with them? What is one small, faithful step you could take this week?
