Discussion Questions

Read Jonah 2:6–10, in verse 7, Jonah says, “I remembered the LORD.” Based on the passage, does it seem like remembering caused God to act, or that Jonah is responding to what God has already done?

Verse 8 says that those who cling to “vain idols” forsake their hope of steadfast love. The word for idols is *hevel* (vapor, emptiness). Read Ecclesiastes 1:2 and Jeremiah 2:12–13. How do these passages deepen your understanding of Jonah 2:8?

What was Jonah clinging to? What are some modern “vapors” we tend to cling to (control, comfort, reputation, success, etc.)? Why do they feel so real and valuable in the moment?

Can you think of a time when you only saw God’s grace clearly after He brought you through something? What changed in your perspective? Why is it often hard to recognize God’s mercy while we are still “in the depths”?

Where do you tend to “try harder” instead of trusting God? What does that look like practically in your life? Why is it easier to rely on effort (fixing, improving, controlling) than to trust God?

How can misunderstanding this truth lead either to fear (I might lose God) or passivity (my choices don’t matter)? How does Jonah’s story help correct both?
