Discussion Questions

In Jonah 2:10, we see the fish obediently “hurling” Jonah onto the shore. In what way is this a picture of spiritual rebirth?

Why is it important that God speaks to Jonah “a second time”? What does this reveal about God’s character?

Why do you think God repeats the same mission instead of giving Jonah a different one? What is different in Jonah 3:2 compared to Jonah 1:2? Why might that small change matter?

What might it mean that God promises to give Jonah “the message that I tell you”? What does that say about dependence on God?

Compare Jonah 1:3 and Jonah 3:3. What is the same, and what is different about Jonah’s response? What does the phrase “according to the word of the LORD” tell us about Jonah’s obedience?

What does Jonah 3:3 say about Nineveh? What details are emphasized? Why is Nineveh described as “a great city to God”? What does that reveal about how God sees people?

What do you notice about the “three days” in Jonah’s experience (in the fish and in the journey)? How does the idea of a journey (three days) shape our understanding of obedience and growth?
