## Discussion Questions

When Jonah is thrown into the sea (Jonah 1:15–16), what do the sailors believe has happened to him? What clues in the text show that they think he is gone for good?

Read Leviticus 16:20-22. What was the purpose of the scapegoat, and how does that help you understand what is happening with Jonah in the storm? In what ways is Jonah like a scapegoat for the sailors, and in what ways does he fall short of that picture?

How does Jesus fulfill what Jonah only points to? What does Jesus accomplish on the cross that Jonah never could? Why is it important that Jesus went willingly into death, rather than being forced into it like Jonah?

Read Matthew 12:38-42. What does Jesus say the “sign of Jonah” is, and what does it reveal about the hearts of the Pharisees? Why does Jesus say the people of Nineveh will condemn that generation? What does that teach us about responding to God’s Word?

Read Matthew 16:5-12. What does Jesus warn His disciples about, and why is this warning given right after talking about Jonah? What does “the leaven of the Pharisees” look like in our lives today?

Jesus didn’t just die for us, He calls us to die with Him. What does it mean in your daily life to “die to yourself” and follow Him? How does the resurrection of Jesus change the way you think about death, fear, and your future?

What does it mean to you personally that Jesus took your place and bore what you deserved? How can you actively thank God this week, not just in words, but in the way you live and treat others?
