## Discussion Questions

Why do you think the author gives us such a short summary of Jonah's message in 3:4? What might this emphasize about God's role in what happens? (Isaiah 55:10–11; Hebrews 4:12)?

What specific actions do the people of Nineveh take to show their response (verses 5–8)? How does the king respond differently from the rest of the people?

What makes this repentance seem genuine? What elements of true repentance do you see in this passage? Why might the Ninevites respond so quickly, even though they know far less about God than Jonah does?

In verse 8, what sins are specifically named? Why is it important that their repentance includes turning from "evil" and "violence"?

What does the phrase "Who knows?" in verse 9 reveal about how the Ninevites view God and themselves? How does knowing Jesus change the way we approach God in repentance?

How do you typically respond when confronted with sin? Do you minimize it, delay dealing with it, or turn from it? What is one practical step you can take this week?

How does the truth that "Jesus paid it all" shape both your confession of sin and your confidence in God's mercy?
