## Discussion Questions

Read **Malachi 3:1–5**. What does Malachi teach us about the messenger who would come before the Lord? Why is the coming of the Lord both good news and a warning?

Read **Isaiah 40:3-5**. John is called “the voice of one crying in the wilderness.” What is the difference between being the voice and being the Savior? How can Christians/churches today be tempted to make themselves central instead of pointing people to Christ?

Read **Mark 1:4–5**. John preached “a baptism of repentance for the forgiveness of sins.” What is repentance? How is repentance more than simply feeling sorry or regretting consequences?

The people came confessing their sins. Why is confession so hard for us? What are some common ways we hide, excuse, minimize, or blame-shift instead of honestly confessing sin before God?

John’s baptism identified repentant people with the covenant promises of God. Why is it important to remember that baptism is not mainly a picture of what we do for God, but a picture of our dependence on the God who washes, forgives, and saves?

Read **Mark 1:6–8 and John 3:27–30**. John was willing to become less so that Christ would become greater. Where do you find it difficult to decrease, step aside, or serve quietly so that Christ receives the attention and glory? How does John’s ministry help us prepare our own hearts to receive and follow Jesus, not only as Savior, but as King?

Read **Ezekiel 36:22–27 and Joel 2:28–32**. How do these passages help us understand John’s statement in Mark 1:8 that Jesus would baptize with the Holy Spirit?
