Discussion Questions

Read Mark 1:9-13. Why is it surprising that Jesus would be baptized by John? What does His baptism teach us about His willingness to identify with sinners, even though He Himself had no sin?

At Jesus' baptism, the heavens are torn open, the Spirit descends, and the Father speaks. What does this passage show us about the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit? Why does it matter that the Trinity is revealed at the beginning of Jesus' public ministry?

The Father says, "You are my beloved Son; with you I am well pleased." How should this declaration shape the way we understand Jesus before He has preached, healed, cast out demons, or gone to the cross?

Immediately after the Father's declaration, the Spirit drives Jesus into the wilderness. How does this comfort us when we face seasons of testing, loneliness, or temptation? Jesus was tempted by Satan in the wilderness for forty days. How does this connect Jesus to Israel's forty years in the wilderness?

Read Hebrews 2:17-18 and Hebrews 4:14-16. How does Jesus' real experience of temptation help us draw near to Him instead of hiding from Him when we are weak or tempted?

Mark tells us Jesus was "with the wild animals, and the angels were ministering to him." What does this detail show us about both the danger of the wilderness and the glory of Jesus? How does this scene remind us that Jesus is both near enough to sympathize with our weakness and strong enough to save and rule over us?
