Discussion Questions

Read Mark 1:14-15. Why do you think Mark mentions John's arrest before telling us that Jesus began preaching? What does John's arrest, and eventual execution, show us about the kind of world Jesus entered?

Jesus begins proclaiming the gospel in Galilee rather than Jerusalem. Why does that matter? What does this tell us about the kind of people Jesus came to seek and save?

Jesus proclaimed "the gospel of God." Why is it important to remember that the gospel is first good news about what God has done, not good advice about what we must do?

Jesus said, "The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand." What does it mean that the kingdom of God has come near in Jesus? How do we see the kingdom breaking in through Jesus' ministry?

Why might the announcement of the kingdom sound like bad news to someone who loves their sin or wants to remain in charge of their own life? How does this help explain why some people opposed Jesus?

Jesus says, "Repent and believe in the gospel." This shows us the Father welcoming sinners. Why is that such good news for those who know they are sinners? Why is it offensive to those who believe they deserve God's welcome on their own merits?

Think about the prodigal son and the older brother in Luke 15. Which brother are you more tempted to resemble: the one running to the far country, or the one standing outside the feast in pride and resentment? Why?
