Discussion Questions

Read Mark 1:40–45. The man says, “If you will, you can make me clean.” Why is that different from asking, “Are you able to make me clean?” Have you ever found it easier to believe that Jesus can show mercy than to believe He is willing to show mercy to you?

Read Leviticus 13:45–46. What would being declared unclean have cost this man socially and religiously? How does that background change the way you understand Jesus deliberately reaching out and touching him?

Jesus tells the cleansed man to show himself to the priest and offer what Moses commanded. Why do you think Jesus insists that the man follow the requirements of the Law rather than simply telling him that those things no longer matter?

When Jesus commands this man to remain silent, the man disobeys Him. Outward cleansing has not automatically produced perfect obedience. Read Mark 7:14–23, where does our deepest defilement actually come from? Why is that a more serious problem than the ceremonial uncleanness of Mark 1?

Read Psalm 51:7–12. David moves from “wash me” and “purge me” to “create in me a clean heart.” What is the difference between wanting Jesus to clean up the consequences of our sin and wanting Him to transform us?

At the beginning of the story, the leper is the one who belongs outside. By verse 45, the man is cleansed and Jesus is forced to remain outside in the desolate places. How does that reversal anticipate what Jesus will ultimately do for sinners? Consider Hebrews 13:12 and 2 Corinthians 5:21.
