Discussion Questions

In Isaiah 60:1, God says, “Arise, shine, for your light has come.” Why is it important that the light comes before the command to shine? Isaiah 60:2 describes darkness covering the earth. What kinds of darkness do we see around us today? What kinds of darkness can creep into the church if we are not watchful?

What does it mean that “the glory of the LORD has risen upon you”? How is that different from simply trying to be positive, moral, or inspiring? Isaiah 60:3 says that “nations shall come to your light.” What does this teach us about the missionary purpose of God’s glory among His people?

In Exodus 33:18, Moses asks the Lord, “Please show me your glory.” What does that request reveal about Moses’ relationship with God? When Moses comes down from the mountain in Exodus 34, his face shines because he has been speaking with God. What does this teach us about the relationship between beholding God and reflecting God?

Why is it dangerous for a church to try to “shine” without first spending time in the presence of God through His Word, prayer, worship, and obedience?

In Matthew 5:16, Jesus says, “Let your light shine before others.” What is the difference between shining faithfully and showing off spiritually? What should they ultimately do because of what they see?

What would it look like for Redeemer to be known not merely as a friendly church, but as a church that reflects the glory, holiness, mercy, and love of God?
