Discussion Questions

Read Mark 1:21-28. What stands out to you most in this passage: Jesus' teaching, the unclean spirit's reaction, Jesus' command, or the crowd's amazement? Why?

Mark says Jesus taught "as one who had authority, and not as the scribes." What is the difference between borrowed authority and Jesus' own authority?

The man with the unclean spirit was found in the synagogue. Why is that sobering? The passage contrasts an unclean spirit with Jesus as the Holy One of God. What does "unclean" mean beyond simply dirty or gross? What does "holy" mean beyond merely morally pure?

The unclean spirit knew true things about Jesus, but he did not love, trust, or worship Jesus. Why is it important to distinguish accurate knowledge about Jesus from saving faith in Jesus?

Jesus tells the spirit, "Be silent, and come out of him." Why does Jesus refuse to let the unclean spirit testify about Him? What are some ways darkness can use even true words in twisted or destructive ways?

The crowd was amazed, but amazement is not the same as discipleship. What is the difference between being impressed by Jesus and surrendering to Jesus?

How does this passage comfort us? How does it confront us?
