Discussion Questions

Read Mark 2:13–17. Why do you think Mark places the calling of Levi immediately after Jesus declares His authority to forgive sins in Mark 2:1–12?

Why might bringing fishermen and a tax collector into the same group have created tension? What does this teach us about the kind of community Jesus creates?

Are there people we find it naturally difficult to imagine being part of our church family, or people we would rather Jesus change before bringing them close to us? How does remembering that Jesus chooses whom He calls challenge that attitude?

Soon Jesus is eating with “many tax collectors and sinners.” How does Jesus demonstrate both genuine holiness and genuine love for sinners without compromising either one?

What does the Scribes’ question reveal about how they see themselves? What are some ways Christians can acknowledge that “everyone is a sinner” while still quietly thinking, “But I’m not that kind of sinner”?

In what ways is sin like a sickness we cannot cure ourselves? Why is admitting our sickness necessary if we are going to come to Christ as our Physician?

If “none is righteous, no, not one,” what does Jesus mean when He says, “I came not to call the righteous, but sinners”? What makes self-righteousness particularly dangerous?

How should knowing that we are sinners saved entirely by grace affect the way we respond when another Christian confesses sin to us? Read James 5:16.
