Discussion Questions

What is the Sabbath? Where did it come from and what is its purpose?

Read Genesis 2:1–3. God rests because His work of creation is finished, not because He is exhausted. Adam's first full day of life is God's seventh day. What might that teach us about the relationship between God's finished work and our work? How is that pattern reflected in the gospel?

Read Exodus 16:22–30. Before the Sabbath command is given at Sinai, God teaches Israel to rest by providing enough manna on the sixth day. Why did resting require faith? What did the people who went out looking for manna on the seventh day reveal about their hearts? Where are you tempted to look for seventh day manna? Where is it difficult for you to stop, let go of control, and trust that God will provide?

Read Deuteronomy 5:12–15. Israel is told to remember that they were once slaves in Egypt. How is Sabbath different for a people who no longer belong to Pharaoh? What “Pharaoh-like” messages does our culture give us about productivity, achievement, and worth?

Why does Jesus bring up David and the bread of the Presence in **Mark 2: 23–28**? Consider not only what David did, but who David was. What might Jesus be revealing about Himself?

Jesus concludes, “The Son of Man is lord even of the Sabbath” (v. 28). Why is that claim bigger than simply saying Jesus has the authority to decide what is permissible on the Sabbath? What does it tell us about Jesus' identity and His relationship to God's rest?

What is the difference between working *for* rest and working *from* rest? How would your ordinary work, obedience, or pursuit of holiness change if you truly believed that the work necessary for your acceptance before God has already been finished by Christ?

Jesus invites weary people to come to Him for rest. What burdens are you tempted to carry as though your relationship with God ultimately depended upon you? What would it look like this week to rest?

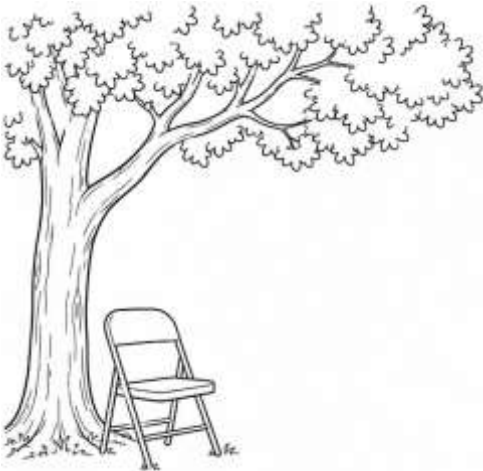
