Discussion Questions

Read Mark 3:20–35. Jesus’ family believes He is “out of his mind,” and the scribes claim He is empowered by Beelzebul. How are these two responses similar, how are they different? Why should we be careful not to treat Jesus’ family and the scribes as equally hardened?

The scribes cannot deny that Jesus is casting out demons, so they explain His power by claiming it comes from Satan. How does Jesus expose the contradiction in their argument in verses 23–26? What does the fact that Satan is losing territory actually tell us about Jesus?

In verse 27 Jesus describes Satan as a “strong man” who must first be bound before his house can be plundered. What does this picture teach us about the reality of Satan’s power? What does it teach us about the greater power of Jesus?

The gospel is sometimes presented mainly as advice about how to become a better or stronger person. What difference is there between trying to become strong enough to rescue ourselves and trusting the One who is strong enough to rescue us?

Read Colossians 1:13–14. Paul describes salvation as being delivered from the “domain of darkness” and transferred into Christ’s kingdom. How does that help explain what Jesus means by plundering the strong man’s house? What changes when someone comes under a new King?

Jesus begins His warning about blasphemy with an extraordinary promise in verse 28. Why is it important to begin there before discussing the unforgivable sin? What does this verse tell us about the extent of Christ’s mercy?

The scribes were saying, “He has an unclean spirit.” Read Isaiah 5:20. What is the difference between misunderstanding what God is doing and becoming so hardened that we call God’s goodness evil? How can obedience be understood as evidence or “family resemblance” produced by belonging to Christ?
