Discussion Questions

Read Mark 3:1–6 together. What contrasts do you notice between the man with the withered hand and the Pharisees?

Verse 2 says they watched Jesus “so that they might accuse him.” What does that reveal about their hearts before Jesus even acts?

Why do you think Jesus tells the man, “Come here,” and places him in the middle of the synagogue? How had the Pharisees begun treating him as a case instead of a neighbor?

Jesus asks, “Is it lawful on the Sabbath to do good or to do harm, to save life or to kill?” How does verse 6 answer that question?

Why is their silence in verse 4 significant? What is the difference between wanting to be right and wanting to know what is right?

Jesus looks at them “with anger, grieved at their hardness of heart.” What do His anger and grief together teach us about how we should respond to sin and error in others?

What can hardness of heart look like in Christian life today?

Where might pride, defensiveness, contempt, or unwillingness to be corrected show up in us?

How can Christians care deeply about sound doctrine without treating every disagreement as heresy or every person who differs from us as foolish or dishonest?

The man responds to Jesus and is restored; the Pharisees resist Jesus and leave plotting destruction. When Jesus confronts something in us, what tends to be our response?

Why is the answer to a hard heart more than simply “try harder to be less stubborn”? What hope does this passage give us in Jesus?
